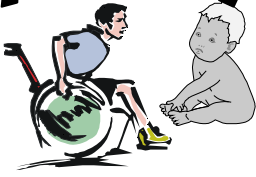

The above names are the orphans whose fees was paid in Ngie in all the 19 villages. The fees ranged from 1000frs to 8.500 per Orphan.
