



## **REPORT TAKEN TODAY 16TH SEPTEMBER DURING THE DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOL MATERIALS AND DRUGS TO ORPHANS AND EPILEPTIC PATIENTS BY ASODI**

The Occasion actually began at 8:00am with the arrival of orphans. At about 9:15a., the various coordinators were charged to arrange the materials and roll call simultaneously. It lasted for 30 minutes.

At 10:00 am, the Rev. father of the St. Joseph's Parish Teze who led us in prayers. In his word of inspiration, he drew his word from the Bible according to St. Luke 6 verses 43 - 45. He called on the almighty God to bless us all and to guide us all to our various homes. He asked the beneficiaries to always put the hierarchy of ASODI into prayers and he ended his sermon by offering 3 bibles to be given next year to outstanding orphans.

The distribution of phenobarb to epileptic patients followed immediately. This lasted briefly for 10 minutes and closely followed was the combasom parts of the program which was the distribution of school materials to about 146 school orphans who answered present to this invitation. This exercise lasted for one hour and all the orphans were given school materials according to their classes. It finally came to an end of 11:46 am with the beneficiaries learning uncommonly. There was some refreshment for the eight coordinators of Lower Ngie and motivation to the coordinators. It was at the 12:00 noon that the program for the Teze Centre rose to an end.

At Andek the ceremony started at 1pm with over 500 orphans and 200 epileptic patients gathered prayers and blessings of the materials was done by the chaplain of Presbyterian High School Andek in the place of the Presbytery secretary who was having a meeting.

This was followed by the distribution of tailoring materials to 8 orphans of upper Ngie and severals materials first were distributed to 10 orphans who are sponsored by ASODI in the college of APC teze. This was also done to the other 10 orphans at Teze. This was then followed by distribution of school materials to the anxious orphans who were so overwhelmed and thank ST John through (ASODI). This took 2hrs and thereafter these was refreshment and transportation equisition to the over 15 coordinators of upper Ngie. Materials were also distributed to 8 orphans carrying out training in tailoring at Teze and Andek
